

Designs for Print

The print designs have been created using a mixture of traditional hand rendered methods such as watercolours, wax resist, batik, decoupage, etching and other print methods, along with some vector (digital) design elements..

They are then scanned and digitally manipulated to create pattern repeats (software today is like witchcraft)

Designs can be recoloured and/or re sized to meet the clients needs, as this can make a radical difference to it's appearance dependent on the end use of the pattern and it's siting.

Patterns are often designed with an end purpose and target in mind but can often be used for a variety of end uses, such as fabrics, tea towels, wrapping paper, duvets, curtains, accessories, stationary etc.
